Adequan/USDF All-Breeds Awards Declaration Information

General

- A horse is eligible for Adequan/USDF All-Breeds Awards based on the breed registry papers and declaration submitted to the USDF office. The All-Breeds Awards Declaration Form must accompany the breed papers, indicating the all-breeds participating organization (PO) that the owner is declaring for.
- A list of POs can be found on the USDF Web site at www.usdf.org. Before submitting the All-Breeds Awards Declaration Form to the USDF office, please be sure the breed registry you are declaring with is a PO in the Adequan/USDF All-Breeds Awards program and that your horse is eligible to receive All-Breeds Awards from the PO.
- Breed registry papers and the All-Breeds Awards Declaration Form must be on file with USDF by August 1 of the award year in order to be eligible for awards during the same year.
- If you are sending pages from a passport, please be sure to include the page with the breed registry's stamp, the pedigree page, and the page that lists the breeder information.
- If eligible for multiple registrations and not previously recorded with USDF, the owner must make a choice of registry for the purpose of Adequan/USDF All-Breeds Awards only. If there is no registry participating in the all-breeds awards program for that breed, the owner may elect one recognizing registry, for which the horse is eligible, for awards.
- This rule does not preclude, eliminate, or interfere with members pursuing awards recognition, or multiple registrations outside the USDF program.
- Incomplete All-Breeds Declaration Forms will not be processed. Please make sure the form is signed and dated.

Foals

- If breed papers have not yet been issued by the registry, a copy of a letter of verification from the registry to the owner will fulfill the breed registry requirements above. This letter must state that the foal is eligible for awards from that registry.
- All foals must have official breed registry papers on file by August 1 of their yearling year in order to maintain eligibility in the Adequan/USDF All-Breeds Awards program.
- After January 1, the horse's declaration will be cleared and a declaration will have to be made by submitting the All-Breeds Awards Declaration Form with a copy of the yearling's official breed registry papers.

Declaration Change

- Once a declaration has been made, it can only be changed by submitting the All-Breeds Awards Declaration Form and declaration change fee (\$50) by August 1 of the current competition year.
- The declaration change fee (\$50) applies to every declaration change, regardless of reason.
